Updates on PM's Disaster Relief Fund Account of the Embassy:-

As of May 06, 2015, Euro 8,929/- has been deposited to the PMDRF account. Out of this amount, NEDEG (Nepali-Deutsche-Gesellschaft) has collected and deposited Euro 4,265/- and the rest by different individuals. We deeply appreciate and thank NEDEG (Chairman Mr. Torsten Frank and the NEDEG family) as well as all the kind-hearted individuals for your generous support and hope it to be continued. The Government of Nepal assures you that every cent you have deposited will be utilized for the welfare of the victims of the earthquake. The Fund is made transparent and audited periodically as per the existing regulations.

Please be informed that, the Government of Nepal has declared the following measures, so far:

- Providing NRs. 40,000/- to perform the last rites for each deceased and NRs. 1,00,000/- as interim relief expenses (Totalling NRs. 1,40,000/- for each deceased -- to be provided to the existing nearest relatives)
- Bearing all the medical costs of treatments for the injured
- Providing loans to the affected families to rebuilt/maintain the damaged homes at a nominal interest rate of 2% through the National Banks
